Items Disallowed in the School

The following items are not allowed, mobile phones, compact discs and players, knives and matches. Tape recorders and laptops are only allowed for specific school assignments.

Refer to the MGIS Student/Parent Handbook and updated handbook amendments for the list of unauthorised items. **Parents should note that confiscated items will not be returned.**

School Uniform/P.E. Attire (sportswear/ Warm Clothing)

Available in the bookstore

Dress/Hair Code - Must be strictly adhered to, or the student will not be allowed in class or to school functions.

Uniforms:

Full prescribed uniforms, a pair of white socks, and Black full-shoes/ black sandals (for girls only) are to be worn to school every day. Students wear their blazers on Mondays.

Tie (compulsory)

Prescribed P.E. attires, white socks and white sneakers are to be worn on specific P.E. days according to the timetable.

Tuesdays:

Top – MGIS House Polo shirts

Down - Trousers for boys /skirts for girls

Shoes – black shoes for boys/ ballerinas or sandals for girls

Fridays:

Top – MGIS white polo shirt.

Down - Skirt for girls, trousers for boys.

Shoes – White sneakers.

Only the School's Warm Clothing will be allowed

(White polo, Blazers and Cardigan, Sweater, etc. are available at the bookstore)

✚ **Dirty, Faded, Torn uniforms are unacceptable.**

Hair Requirements: *Hair should be kept tidy and neat*

Girls :

- Must avoid weave-on, wigs, scarves, headgear, hijab, turban, coloured braids and dyeing of hair, nose studs, necklace, anklets, and bracelets are not allowed.
- Natural long hair must always be neatly held in a bun or shoulder level regardless of ethnicity.
- Large braids are disallowed (thin braids preferred).
- Not more than a pair of earrings. Bangles (thread, rubber, plastic etc.) are not allowed.

Boys:

- are not allowed to fade, braid, plait, curl, dye their hair, or any form of mohawk, wear nose rings and earrings, bangles, chains or rings.
- Hair should be very short and evenly cut regardless of ethnicity.
